TUITION REMISSION PROGRAM FOR DEPENDENT CHILDREN/ SIBLINGS OR SPOUSE/DOMESTIC PARTNER OF FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES

A. General Program Description

The tuition waiver program provides partial waiver of tuition costs at New Jersey City University for eligible dependent children/siblings of full-time University employees. To receive this waiver the student must fulfill the academic and administrative requirements for admission, apply for all available State and Federal grants and scholarships, and receive a passing grade. The cost of tuition only is waived. If the student does not receive a passing grade for the course(s) for which the waiver has been granted, reimbursement to the University for all-waived costs will be required. Until this is done no other waivers will be granted. All fees and additional charges are the responsibility of the student.
